#### **BLANKET**

#### 1.) Chain 150

- 2.j 1 dc in 2nd stitch from the hook, \*1 ch, skip 1 stitch, 1 dc in next stitch\*, turn
- 3.) 2 ch, skip the dc from the first row, \*1 dc in the chain space, 1 chain\* Finish with 1 dc in the last ch from the previous row.

Repeat row 3 until the work measures 69 cm.

#### HOOD

1.)	3 ch, in first ch work 1 dc,
	1 ch, 1 dc, 2 ch turn work
2.)	1 dc, 1 ch, 1 dc into ch space,
	1 ch, 1 dc in last st, 2 ch turn work
21	1 ala *1 ala 1 ala anno al ala anno 3

1 dc, \*1 ch, 1 dc around ch space\*, 3.) 1 dc in last st, 2 ch turn work

Repeat row 3 a total of 35 times Sew the hood on as shown.

#### EARS 2 X

1.) mr with 6 dc	(6)
2.) *2 dc inc*	(12)
3.) *1 dc, 2 dc inc*	(18)
4.) *2 dc, 2 dc inc*	(24)
5.) *3 dc, 2 dc inc*	(30)
6.) 30 dc	(30)
7.) *3 dc, dc 2 tog*	(24)
8.) *2 dc, dc 2 tog*	(18)
9.) *1 dc, dc 2 tog*	(12)

Sew the ears to the hood.

#### EYES 2 X 1.) mr with 6 dc

(6)

Sew the eyes to the hood. Embroider the nose/mouth on as a "Y".

#### **PICOT EDGE**

\*3 ch, 1 dc in the third ch, skip 1 dc, 1 dc\*

Repeat around.



## GOOD TO KNOW

### Needle Size & Tension

Knitters knit very differently: some knit with a needle size 2,0 mm and obtain the same size of design quality as a person who knits with a needle size 4,0 mm. We owe this knowledge to the team of knitters who join us. The key to knit a specific size is a lot about the knitting style/hands/ skills, rather than the size of needles. Therefore, we will recommend a range of needle sizes







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
